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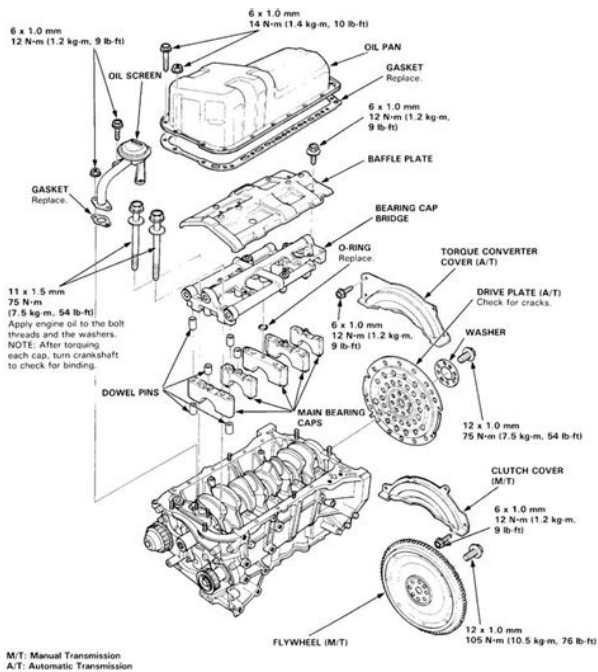

If the belt doesnt retract easily, pull it out and check for twists or kinks. 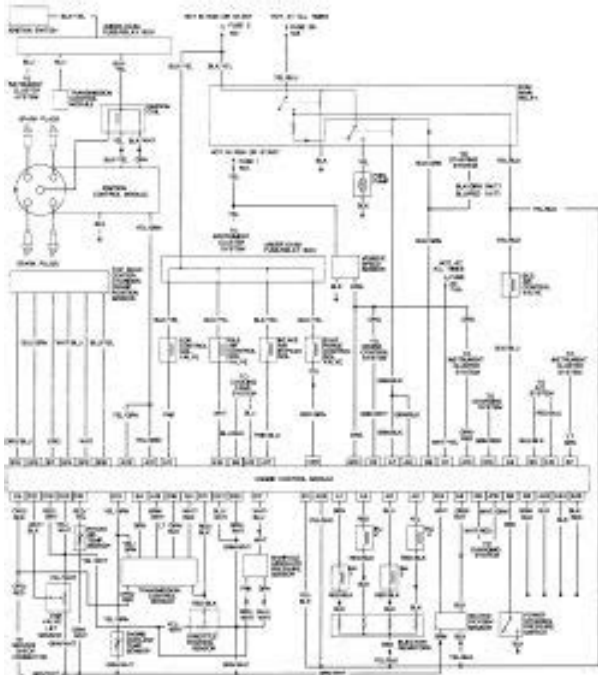
To unlatch the belt, push the red PRESS button on the buckle. Pull out each belt fully and look for frays, cuts, burns, and wear. Any belt not in good condition or not working properly should be replaced. This system does not replace your seat belt. It supplements, or adds to, the protection offered by your seat belt. Not wearing a seat belt increases the chance of serious injury or death in a crash, even if you have airbags. An indicator light to warn you of a possible problem with the system. Emergency power backup in case your cars electrical system is disconnected in a crash. When the airbag inflates, you may hear a fairly loud noise and you might see smoke and powder. This is normal; it is caused by the inflation of the airbag. To do its job, the airbag inflates with considerable force. Because infants must ride in a reclining position, be sure the infant seat always faces the REAR of the car as shown. The preferred place to put a toddler seat is in the center position of the rear seat. Use the car's lap belt to secure the seat to the car. Remove the plug cover from the attachment points shown in the illustration, then install the tether hardware that came with the child seat. Tighten the bolt to 22 N.m (2.2 kgm, 16 lbft). Pull on the shoulder part of the belt to make sure there is no slack in the lap portion. Whichever style you select, follow the booster seat manufacturer's instructions. You should continue to press on the brake pedal with the same force. You may feel a slight movement of the brake pedal just after you start the engine. This is the ABS working.

**Headlight High Beam Indicator Light** This blue indicator light will go on whenever the high beams are switched on see page 49 . If the light does not go off when the parking brake is released with the ignition ON, or if it comes on while driving, it indicates a burnt out highbeam bulb. Checking the Safety Indicator Lights. 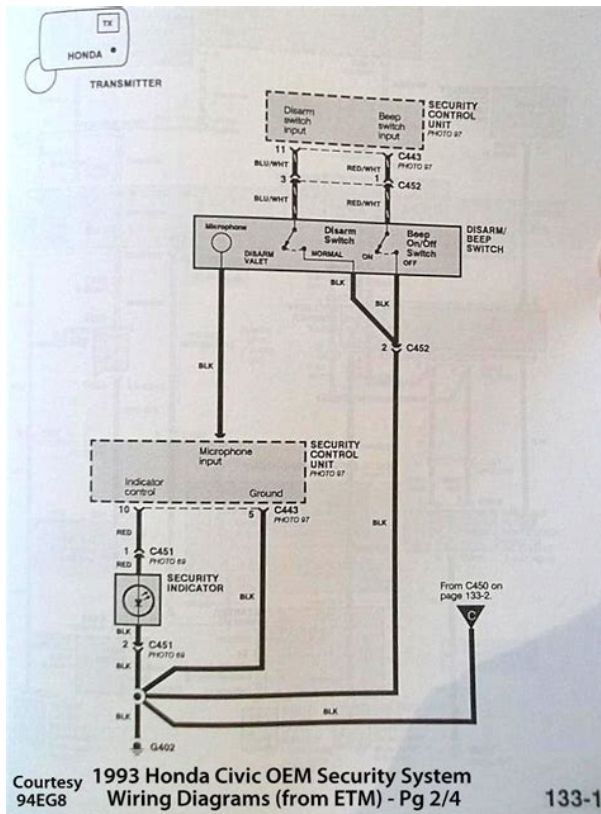

Always stop the engine before refueling, and never refuel near sparks or open flames.

Manual Transmission 1. Apply the parking brake. 2. Push the clutch pedal all the way in see NOTE below. 3. Shift the transmission to neutral. The mirrors are properly adjusted, and the windows clean. The driver and passengers are wearing properly adjusted seat belts. The front seat head restraints are properly adjusted. The warning and indicator lights are operating properly. Decreased traction could cause loss of directional control. You should have your car and trailer weighed at a commercial weighing station to check. Never load the trailer so that the back is heavier than the front. Check for correct operation of the turn signals and stop lights each time you hitch up. A trailer lighting connector is provided behind the left garnish by the taillight access door in the trunk. A converter, available at most trailer supply stores, should be installed according to the instructions supplied by the converter manufacturer. Avoid sudden braking which may cause trailer jackknifing and loss of control. Avoid jerky starts and rapid acceleration. If your car has a manual transmission, always start out in first gear and release the clutch at moderate engine rpm. Avoid rapid lane changing and sharp turns. Because of the added load of the trailer, your cars engine may overheat on hot days. Turning off the air conditioner will reduce the load on the cooling system.

Use a good quality liquid or paste wax, and follow the manufacturers instructions. Wax all the metal trim to keep its luster.

Rust Prevention Rusting is likely to occur in parts of the car where water is trapped or where there is continual dampness. Water will collect inside doors and body panels if drain holes become clogged. Replace with a tire of exactly the same size and construction. I liked the interior of the 9091 Accords better then that of the 9293 Accords. The car has been great,

pretty reliable. Cranks over on those cold 15 Wisconsin winter mornings. Warms up quick and gets you up to speed a moderate amount of time.

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I've averaged 19 mpg every tank for the last two months but the car has 200,000 miles so that may be why, my old 1991 now driven by my father averages 26 mpg. They aren't big cars but seat four comfortably. I just wish the mpgs were a bit higher. I would drive my car to California or Alaska from Wisconsin in a heartbeat. It doesn't skip a beat and I feel safe driving it. I can't see how there can be a better car on the market. Interior features began to fail a number of years back but kept moving. Other than changing the timing belt at 90k, the car had never seen the inside of the dealership or mechanic shop. Had rust not begun its work and if I had a place to park it my 15 year old would have been driving when she got her license. The manual transmission is a must. I have had a few minor problems such as the muffler falling off due to rust, and the alternator has been replaced once, the engine has minor idling problems and the suspension needs to be replaced. The exterior is still in great shape with little to no surface rust, and the interior is also in great shape with no tears and minor wear. All in all this has been the best car I could have hoped for. After 120,000 miles the factory exterior paint, as well as the interior upholstery, looks brand new. It doesn't use a drop of oil and it's as peppy as the day I bought brand it new. My only complaint is the retractable antenna which leaves six inches still sticking out when the radio is turned off. If I was really bothered about that, it's easily replaced. So far, this car has lasted 15 years 113k miles and is doing just fine for its seniority. There have only been a few minor problems with this car, and just one major one, unlike other cars in this one's class.

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The clutch busted while cruising through a leveled parking lot easily fixed, the heater doesn't work anymore, the glove compartment never closes all the way so the light stays on, and the antenna has some problems moving up and down, but opening and slamming the trunk fixes that. I have loved this car. It was not only reliable, but easy to own. I gave it back to her a few months ago, and hope to buy another one soon. I had so few problems, that I have nothing to list. All I can say is with proper maintenance these cars last a life time. Would definitely buy again. I replaced it with an 05 Accord, and it's a nice car, but I miss the old one. I still look on line to find a rust-free one to have as my day to day car. Car never let me down, and the interior looked brand new when I sold it. It is very reliable and low maintenance.
